



The property is a real Peacehaven for children and animals as it is positioned in a quiet cul-de-sac, where residents can take advantage of the beautifully landscaped five acres of communal grounds and woodlands.

Cedar Chase comprises a small private development of 24 houses and forms part of the Taplow Conservation area. The properties were designed on the site of Taplow Hill House, around 3 large Cedar trees in the 1960's by Eric Lyons, who was the principal architect for Span housing.

The concept of Span housing, after the post-war period, was to instigate a strong community feel with shared gardens and landscaping, which encouraged people to interact together. Cedar Chase remains one of the most attractive, best kept Span estates in Britain and retains its community atmosphere and original architectural charm.

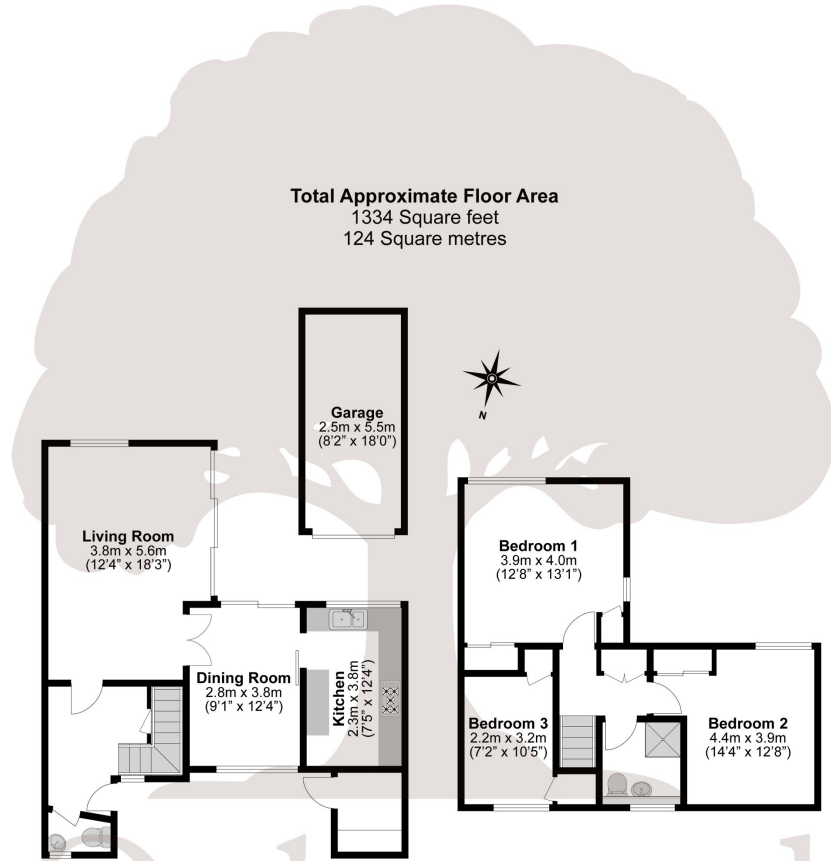
Service Charge Information
